AGM round up.

For those not at the AGM the main points of note were the retirement of Dhilip Khatri as a trustee and his replacement by Babu Bhai Chawda plus agreed changes to the constitution. The main two been the simplification of the nomination process (only requiring the name to pass through the council once). Also the formalizing of the council with the two VPs been named (one VP Admin & the other VP Social). The Social & Public Relations Director's position has been taken up by VP Social and the Gym director has been reintroduced. Also of the two Committee Members one has been replaced by the Snooker Director. This keeps the overall council at eleven. This year as this was a new change to the constitution it was agreed that we would have two committee members but if any voting was needed one would remain silent. The other point of note was the agreement to spend over 50% of the previous year's membership fees on Club improvements.

1) Kitchen

The kitchen is the top priority and is presently closed until the upgrade is complete.

(AS) to come up with more detailed plans for the kitchen.

It must be a good quality commercial kitchen with stainless steel worktops and commercial stove / oven. The extension and upgrade should allow easy access from outside for the bowlers and swimmers. While fitting in with the proposed covered walkway to the entrance. Also be mind full of the needs of the squash players and the future plans for glass backed courts with stadium seating to ground level.

2) Club Furniture

Quotes are already well under way for new furniture for the club.

Timeline: Before mid July.

3) Swimming Pool BBQ area

Plans are already been circulated with the concreting / paving of the pool side area. The pool changing rooms are below par. There is also a need for shade from the sun and protection from rain for swimmers & spectators.

Regular maintenance issues require the purchase of a back up pump plus under filters etc. Quotes are been sourced from NZ. .

Subcommittee: Gerald Erbsleben.

SK to advise on pump under filter etc

Timeline: Swimmers winter break mid June to mid July.

4) Bar / Balcony Extension

(AS) has provided detailed plans that are presently with builders for quotes. Builders are coming back with more detailed questions re the specs & an engineering drawing needs to be done if we are to pursue this seriously.

The Bar upgrade with the removal of the big freezer and replacement with under bar coolers etc needs more quotes and drawings but it was agreed that both projects would be well over \$150,000.

The converted area below the balcony could also double as another bar.

It is been questioned if the club numbers justify the balcony extension just yet!

Subcommittee: Adam.

Timeline: Awaiting quotes and input from the House Committee & finance director.

5) Car Park, Security & Main Club Entrance

A major point is the lack of adequate parking (AS) suggested moving court 1 to beside the multi court and converting the multi court to astro turf and having the multi court in behind the swimming pool changing rooms / pump house. It was agreed that this would be a major capital cost.

(BC) suggested that an easier / cheaper option would be to utilize the existing vacant land next to the current entrance to the club. It was pointed out that if this did not belong to the club it was only a temporary fix. It was suggested that the club should look at purchasing the land with a view to re align the road and have a decent sized car park using the existing entrance way as the main entrance.

It has been questioned if we need more land or should make do with what we have

Subcommittee: SK PR (Security / cameras etc Mike Jamison).

Timeline: Security cameras to be installed ASAP, Larger work SK to report back
